

Welcome to the eighth edition of Italy on Screen Today - New York Film & TV Series Fest: a week-long celebration featuring live events in Manhattan and online on Mymovies.it. Directed by Loredana Commonara, the festival is set to showcase the pinnacle of contemporary Italian cinema and TV series, made possible through the generous contribution of the Ministry of Culture and Tourism - General Administration of Cinema, with the support of Italian General Consulate of Italy in New York, the Italian Cultural Institute in New York, Casa Italiana Zerilli - Marimò Auditorium/New York University, and Rai Cinema, in collaboration with Italy for Movies and, starting from this year, New York Film Academy.

The inaugural event holds significant importance as it marks the unveiling and promotion of the Italian film *Io capitano* by Matteo Garrone, contending for the honor of representing Italy in the International Feature Film Award category at the 2024 Oscars. Festivities will commence on December 4th with an afternoon press conference at the Consulate General of Italy in New York, featuring director Matteo Garrone, lead actors Seydou Sarr and Moustapha Fall, and screenplay advisor Mamadou Kouassi. Later that evening, at the esteemed Robin Williams Theater, an exclusive venue from SAG-AFTRA foundation in the heart of Manhattan, the film *Io capitano* will be screened. Following the screening, a Q&A session moderated by journalist Silvia Bizio with the esteemed guests is anticipated, drawing the presence of a special delegation from the Academy Motion Picture Arts and Sciences (AMPAS), Golden Globe Voters, Critics Choice Awards voters.

The festival will unfold at the prestigious Casa Italiana Zerilli - Marimò Auditorium at New York University, featuring unmissable events. In the Corti d'autore section, director Peter Marcias will introduce his film *The External Gaze*, while actress Lucia Sardo will delve into her featured work, *Due mondi separati*. The program will also feature the latest masterpiece from maestro Bellocchio, *Kidnapped*, previously showcased in competition at the Cannes Film Festival. A highly anticipated event is the celebration of the 20th anniversary of *La meglio gioventù*, Marco Tullio Giordana's seminal coming-of-age film that marked a milestone in Italian cinema of the new millennium. The protagonists, Sonia Bergamasco and Fabrizio Gifuni, will engage in a special conversation during which they will be honored with the Italy on Screen Excellence Award.

From December 4th to December 10th, an exclusive program will be available on Mymovies.it throughout the United States. This program will encompass a diverse array of offerings, including works from both established and emerging auteurs, documentaries, and TV series, all available for streaming. New this year is a display featuring the top creations by students from Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia: ten short films currently earning awards and acclaim at major festivals around the world. The festival's rich lineup includes American and New York premieres, ensuring a captivating experience for cinephiles of all tastes and preferences.

This year again, Italy On Screen Today New York is partnering with Italy for Movies (www.italyformovies.com), the portal for Italian locations and funding incentives managed by Cinecittà, in collaboration with Italian Film Commissions, and coordinated by Direzione Generale Cinema e Audiovisivo (Ministry of Culture). The portal, available as an app from digital stores, provides a range of useful information on locations and funding opportunities available for productions wanting to shoot in Italy, in addition to industry news, interesting information and itinerary suggestions for cinema lovers who want to visit the locations featured on screen.





IO CAPITANO, by Matteo Garrone. Cast: Seydou Sarr, Moustapha Fall, Issaka Sawagodo. ITA, BEL, 2023 - 121 mi. Prod: Archimede with Rai Cinema and Tarantula with Pathé, Logical Content Ventures with the support of the Ministry of Culture, with the participation of Canal +, Cine +, in co-production with Rtbf (Belgian Television), Voo-Be TV and Proximus. Io Capitano tells the story of the adventurous journey of Seydou and Moussa, two young men who leave Dakar to make their way to Europe. A contemporary Odyssey through the dangers of the desert, the horrors of the detention centers in Libya and the perils of the sea.

Following by Q&A with special guests director Matteo Garrone, the lead actors Seydou Sarr, Moustapha Fall and the screenplay advisor Mamadou Kouassi with the journalist Silvia Bizio.



Matteo Garrone was born in Roma in 1968. After graduating he took interest in painting and then decided to enter the world of audio visuals. In 1997 he shot a documentary in New York with Carlo Cresto-Dina called *Bienvenido Espirito Santo*. With Cresto-Dina, 1998, he worked on the documentary *Oreste Pipolo*, fotografo di matrimoni and in the same year he also made his second feature, *Ospiti*, which received a special mention at the Mostra Internazionale d'Arte Cinematografica di Venezia. In 2000 he approached the comedy genre in *Estate romana*; in 2002 he won the critics appraisal thanks to the *L'imbalsamatore*, with which he won the David di Donatello Award for best screenplay. In 2008 he directed the adapta-

tion of Roberto Saviano's bestseller *Gomorra* which won him the Grand Prix at the Cannes Festival and several David di Donatello awards. Four years later he was back in Cannes with *Reality*, which was awarded the Jury's Grand Prix as well as two Nastri d'Argento and three David di Donatello awards. In 2015 he made the *Tale of Tales* – Il racconto dei racconti: the flick won seven David di Donatello awards, including Best Director. Both *Tale of Tales* and *Dogman* (2018) were selected to compete for the Palme d'Or at Cannes Film Festival and the Nastro d'Argento awarded Garrone both Best Producer and Best Director with *Dogman*, then he received the latter again for *Pinocchio*. In 2023 with lo capitano, he won the Leone d'Argento as Best Director at the Mostra Internazionale d'Arte Cinematografica di Venezia.



Seydou Sarr is 21 years old, and in 2023, he won the Marcello Mastroianni Award, which is awarded to the best emerging actor or actress at the Venice International Film Festival. He played his role alongside **Moustapha Fall**, 23 years old, both Senegalese and making their debut in the film industry.




Mamadou Kouassi Pli Adama was born in 1983 in Ivory Coast. In 2001, while pursuing language studies at university, he was forced to flee to Ghana with his family due to the civil war. It took him three years to cross the desert and reach Italy, overcoming prison camps. For a long period, he was a victim of exploitation, from Calabria to Puglia, Piedmont, and Val di Susa. Today, he works as a cultural mediator and is a reference point at the Csa in the former Canapificio in Caserta. His story served as inspiration for the director Matteo Garrone.

Internal and visual notes of an elderly director about to shoot her latest documentary. An intimate monologue suspended between past and present: thoughts, images, moods, primordial landscapes, the gazes of three traveling artists (Vittorio Alinari, Gaston Vuillier, Paolo Ventura) become suggestions and an author's search for elusive inspiration.



Peter Marcias was born in Oristano in 1977. Director and screenwriter, in 2008 he made his debut with *Suspended followed by The children of his life, My destiny, Our quarantine*. His works, presented in the most prestigious international festivals, testify to a strong interest in a cinema linked to artistic, social and political themes. His 2010 documentary film *Liliana Cavani* was nominated for the 2011 Nastri D'Argento; in 2014 *About Piera*, on the figure of the great actress Piera Degli Esposti, received the special Nastro D'Argento and was broadcast with great success on Sky Arte. In 2020 *Nilde lotti, Women's Turn* was screened as a world premiere at the Giornate degli Autori of the 77th Venice Film Festival, as in 2023 *Marching People* at the Rome Film Festival.

In 1858, in the Jewish quarter of Bologna, the Pope's soldiers burst into the home of the Mortara family. By order of the cardinal, they have come to take Edgardo, their seven-year-old son. The child had been secretly baptized by his nurse as a baby and the papal law is unquestionable: he must receive a Catholic education. Edgardo's parents, distraught, will do anything to get their son back. Supported by public opinion and the international Jewish community, the Mortaras' struggle quickly took a political dimension. But the Church and the Pope will not agree to return the child, to consolidate an increasingly wavering power.



Maria, a 70-year-old writer, after years spent in northern Italy, returns to her native land in Calabria: her lifestyle is frowned upon by the town-speople and she is determined not to give up her freedom. The woman is in a relationship with Antonio, a mechanic thirty years younger, and he is conditioned by the prejudices of the people of the town and above all of his father, who does not accept his son's relationship with an older woman.



Lucia Sardo was born in Francofonte in 1952. She studied at the drama school of the Teatro di Ventura under Ferruccio Merisi and she had a brilliant stage career for fifteen years. She made her film debut in the 1992 Aurelio Grimaldi drama La discesa di Aclà a Floristella, and two years later she got her first major role in Grimaldi's La ribelle e Le buttane. Her breakout came in 2001, with the role of Felicia, Giuseppe Impastato's mother, in Marco Tullio Giordana's I cento passi: for her performance she was nominated for Nastro d'Argento in the "supporting actress" category. In 2021 she had the major role in From scratch, a Netflix series by Attica and Tembi Locke.


A family saga set in Italy from 1966 through 2003, it chronicles the life of the middle-class Carati family, focusing primarily on brothers Nicola and Matteo as their life paths separate during youth, encompassing major political and social events in post-World War II Italian history. At first they shared the same dreams, the same hopes, the same books and friendships. Meeting Giorgia, a girl with mental disorders, will be determinant for the future of the two brothers: Nicola decides to become a psychiatrist, Matteo abandons his studies and joins the police.

Conversation with lead actors Sonia Bergamasco and Fabrizio Gifuni with the journalist Silvia Bizio, followed by Italy On Screen Excellence Award Ceremony



Sonia Bergamasco was born in Milano in 1966. Bergamasco graduated in piano at the Giuseppe Verdi Conservatory and then enrolled the drama school of the Piccolo Teatro, graduating in 1990 and she made her stage debut with Giorgio Strehler and she had a brilliant stage international career directed by Bene, Latella, Fabre, Terzopoulos. She made her film debut in 1994, in the film Miracoli, storie per corti, in the segment Antonio Mastronunzio pittore sannita directed by Mario Martone. In 2001 she had her breakout role as Sofia, the main character in Giuseppe Bertolucci's L'amore probabilmente. In 2004 thanks to her performance in La meglio gioventù by Marco Tullio Giordana, she won the Nastro d'Argento for Best

Actress along with the rest of the female cast. She has also worked with directors Bernardo Bertolucci, Giuseppe Piccioni, Roberta Torre and Franco Battiato. She received the Premio Flaiano for best actress for her role in Liliana Cavani's film *De Gasperi* and has enjoyed continued success in the TV series *Tutti pazzi per amore* e *Una grande famiglia*, by Riccardo Milani. She actually plays Livia on the long-running TV show *Il commissario Montalbano*.



Fabrizio Gifuni was born in Roma in 1966. He is one of the most successful actors on the Italian film and theatre scene. After completing his studies with Orazio Costa at the Accademia Nazionale d'Arte Drammatica Silvio d'Amico in 1992, Gifuni had a brilliant international career as stage actor, directed by Castri, Ronconi, Terzopoulos, Tiezzi.

He made his film debut in 1996, in *La bruttina stagionata*. Two years later he had his breakout role as Pelaia in Gianni Amelio's Così ridevano, then in 1999 he received a nomination for Best Actor at the David di Donatello for his performance in *Un amore*. In 2002 Gifuni was appointed EFP Shooting Star at the Berlin International Film


Festival for his performance in Giuseppe Bertolucci's *L'amore probabilmente*. In 2003 thanks to his performance in *La meglio gioventù* by Marco Tullio Giordana he received his second nomination for David di Donatello and won the Nastro d'Argento for Best Actor along with the rest of the male cast. He received a third nomination for David di Donatello in 2012, for Giordana's *Romanzo di una strage*. In 2014 he won the David di Donatello for Best Supporting Actor and the Nastro d'Argento for Best Actor for his role in *Il capitale umano*, by Paolo Virzì. In 2023 he won the David di Donatello for Best Actor for his role of Aldo Moro in Marco Bellocchio's *Esterno notte*.



However, when he reaches out to his father to ask for help, Orlando feels he must oblige. For the first time in his life, he leaves the town and travels to Brussels to see Valerio, only to arrive when it is too late. His son is dead, leaving behind a twelve-year-old daughter, Lyse.









Nur's strong will to proselytize, together with the strict orders of the leader of the camp, will unfold into an attempt to convert Sara and make her join Islamic extremism.





Her light-heartedness is protected by her mother who always accompanies her with dedication. One morning the mother witnesses a quarrel between Giulia and some arrogant children who exclude her from a game. Giulia does not know how to rebel and she also gets angry with her mother who instead scolds the arrogant child and her mother.

Nadia, a solitary and wary girl, wears a patch over one eye. On the bank of the river, in search of adventures in the company of some stray kittens, she sees a young man ill-treated by boys from the village and shut up in an abandoned shack. Nadia goes away. But then, curious, she goes back and tries to set the "prisoner" free. The wall that separates them opens up for Nadia the possibility of playing at being someone else and experiencing, in this fascination, a sudden desire to grow.

In the bowels of a city of the dead, in a world that has been ravaged and is now unrecognizable, Marcello lives surrounded by Sicilian puppets. Time and captivity have twisted him; in order to survive in a hostile, incomprehensible environment, he goes ahead with a diabolical plan to obtain a weapon that will protect him and give him power. Things will work out somewhat differently.


At the end of the sixties, a trial was held in Rome that caused a sensation. Playwright and poet Aldo Braibanti was sentenced to nine years' prison, found guilty of plagio. That is, of having submitted another person, physically and psychologically, to his own will. In this case, a student and friend who was barely of age. The youth's family had him committed to a psychiatric hospital and subjected to a string of devastating electroshock treatments to "cure" him of that "diabolical" influence. Some years later, the crime of plagio was removed from the Italian penal code.

This is the tale of the life of Marco Carrera, known as Colibrì, the hummingbird: a life of fateful coincidences, loss, and stories of absolute love. The strength of recollections allows us to leap from one period to another, from one era to another, in a fluid time ranging from the early 1970s to a near future. Il Colibrì is the story of the ancestral force of life, of the arduous struggle we all make to withstand what at times appears intolerable – also by wielding the powerful weapons of illusion, happiness, and good cheer.

Who are today's children? What do they think and how do they manage to grasp the adult world? To answer these questions, the director Sophie Chiarello decides to follow the pupils of a primary class in a school immersed in a multi-ethnic neighborhood. For five years with her camera, she lowers her gaze to child height to capture their point of view of the world. The Circle is not a documentary about children, but with children. Disarming and genuine as only they know how to be.

Garfagnana and the Middle Serchio Valley are borderlands shrouded in the mystery of ancient legends and superstitions that for millennia have been ingrained in the behavior and customs of its inhabitants. This remote area located in Tuscany has an intangible heritage of oral tradition that has been fading in recent decades.

What survives today of these ancient beliefs in the behaviors and lifestyles of new generations of native inhabitants?

Haug soon brought together his own collaborators in virtual production, lensing and VFX.
