Above all, the festival will be divided into two parts.

The first part kicks off on December 3rd and will be running till December 8th, 2021. It will be online, and film will be streamed through MyMovies.it platform: over the six days, films will be available across the United States for everyone who wants to watch the films in program. In this way, the festival is able to reach an audience that would hardly have the opportunity to enjoy Italian cinema in New York. The program includes contemporary and dynamic products of the best Italian production of 2021 and offers first and second feature, documentaries, a little gem of animation, and, of course, the great authors.

And, beware, we're only talking about **premiers**.

The second part will take place in person in New York next spring. The program includes more films and an entire section dedicated to TV series, along with presentation showcases and interactive panels, the Wind of Europe International Award, guests from the entertainment and audiovisual industry: because the main objective is the internationalization of Italian productions. There will be great surprises, we are already at work.



NY PREMIERE THE INNER CAGE





In a suspended atmosphere, the rules that keep them separate are slackened and new forms of relationship emerge among the remaining men.



As the streets empty and life grinds to a halt out of fear of the terrorist attack, four men and four women will put their feelings for each other to the test, with their relationships either sinking or rising to the surface. The first Italian film entirely shot remotely during the 2020 COVID-19 lockdown.

Allegra is a lively young woman with a passion for high mountain climbing. She decides to travel to Morocco to reach the top of the Atlas, but her trip ends abruptly when a man explodes a bomb in a coffee shop and her three friends die in the attack. Unable to overcome the trauma months later she returns to her city, where the encounter with Arad, a young Muslim refugee, forces her to confront her perception of reality, her fears and heal her profound interior wounds.

BAD POET

Even though D'Annunzio accepts honors and appointments from Mussolini, the Duce fears him and sends a young Italian federal agent to watch over the evil poet. Yet the poet, even if old and tired, hasn't lost his seductive skills. Will they charm the young soldier to the point of making him question himself and its faith to Fascism?

However, little by little Amicangelo manages to access Nino's vivid memories and deep feelings. Even though she's dead, he still feels his beloved Caterina at his side and communicates with her. Much to his reluctance, Amicangelo gets closer and closer to Nino's treasured private world, filled with thoughts, love, and emotions.





A man, chased by the police after a robbery, enters a bakery and takes the patrons hostage. Marco is an improvised robber, but in reality, he is a small businessman who freaks out after the umpteenth tax bill. A human mix finds itself trapped in a tragicomic situation: Ambra, a former nurse, now a prostitute; Regina, a cardiac pensioner with a revolutionary spirit; Remo, a fearful and aggressive baker; Ismail a wise Somali street vendor. The Commissioner and the negotiator Anna must resolve the situation, where the game becomes more and more unpredictable.

The main character of the film is a 17,000-m2 building occupied by squatters, famous for the intervention of the papal almoner in helping its residents; it is a political and social experiment in progress. Voting on issues keeps getting postponed; a performance has unusual rules and objectives. These two plot lines interact with each other in surprising ways, even for the film's creators, and this allows us to understand a situation the existence of which we could never have imagined, one that seems remote and yet so familiar.



CERCANDO EUROPA





In the middle of the Mediterranean Sea, there is a small and remote island called Ventotene. Over 80 years ago on this island, a group confined there in isolation by the fascist regime started working on an idea which envisioned a united Europe capable of ending all conflicts and wars: the Ventotene Manifesto written by Altiero Spinelli and Ernesto Rossi, one of the fundamental documents for the birth of the European Union. Today, 7 young European activists have come to Ventotene looking towards the future of Europe and how young people could help shape it.

Ventotene and S. Stefano, two small islands of the Tyrrhenian Sea. Today the islands offer the great spectacle of nature, preserving ancient traditions and maintaining the historical memory of European federalism. It is in the small island of Ventotene, in fact, that during the fascist period the first idea of a free and united Europe was born. A journey through time, to understand what has changed above and below the waters of Ventotene and Santo Stefano.
